Problem Solving

In 2001, the Juvenile Probation Department began a program aimed at preventing juveniles from formally entering into the juvenile justice system.

The Crisis Intervention program is designed to take a proactive approach with juveniles who are on the verge of falling into the system. Referrals are received from parents, schools, and law enforcement agencies requesting emergency intervention for “out of control” juveniles.

There is a meeting with families to gather information concerning the child’s behavior and counsels with the child and family explaining the laws regarding delinquent youth and possible consequences for further actions.

Recovery


If appropriate, referral resources are provided to the parents for psychological or substance abuse counseling. Tours of the facility are arranged to allow the juvenile to experience what being detained will feel like.

Referrals to Motivation Day are also an option for parents who feel their child needs a little more encouragement towards a change. Motivation Day is held at the Juvenile Leadership Academy in Arcola, Texas.

Beginning October -May, every other Friday, this one time only 4 hour session involves intense physical training, learning how to maintain discipline, and end of session counseling. For more information on Motivation Day, feel free to ask during the Crisis Intervention session.

Results

The success of this program can be associated with a reduction in delinquent referrals to the department, regarding referrals of the youth served by this program.
