
After considering the case load of the 268th District Court currently existing and after consulting with the Administrative Judge for the District Courts of Fort Bend County, Texas it is the considered opinion of this Court that all family law cases currently assigned to the 268th District Court be transferred to the 328th District Court, the 387th District Court and the 505th District Court evenly between them and that no further family law cases be assigned to the 268th District Court.

IT IS, THEREFORE, HEREBY ORDERED that all family law cases currently filed in and assigned to the 268th District Court be filed in and transferred to the 328th District Court, the 387th District Court and the 505th District Court evenly between them effective December 1, 2018.


IT IS FURTHER, ORDERED, that no further family law cases shall be filed or assigned to the 268th District Court effective December 1, 2018.
