Permits for the Construction of Driveways & Culverts on County Easements and Right of Ways in Fort Bend County

SECTION 1 - DEFINITIONS

As used in these requirements, the following words and phrases have the following meanings:

- A. County or public easements or right of way: Any right, title or interest in land acquired, claimed or maintained by Fort Bend County for road and road drainage.
- B. Person: Any individual, corporation, partnership, limited partnership, joint venture or other entity.
- C. County Engineer: The County Engineer of Fort Bend County, Texas.
- D. Road and Bridge: The Fort Bend County Road and Bridge Department.
- E. Roadway: The portion of the improved surface of the County or public easement or right of way used for travel by vehicular traffic which is usually constructed of concrete, asphalt, gravel, or other material providing a hard surface.
- F. Driveway: An improved surface used for vehicular access from the edge of a County roadway to the right of way or easement line.
- G. Culvert: A hollow structure of concrete, or other substance, which provides waterway openings to conduct water for drainage purposes.
- H. Start of Construction: The commencement of any grading, excavation, removal of concrete curb, setting of culvert pipe on County or public easements or right of way.
- I. Bonds: The approved form of security furnished by the Permit Applicant and his sureties conditioned upon the faithful performance of the work in strict accordance with all applicable requirements, plans and specifications.
