## FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – December 2019

From December 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 96.4%. The save rate for dogs was 97.5% and for cats it was 95%.\* The overall save rate for FBCAS utilizing the formula through the Best Friends Community Dashboard was 95%\*\*

- 92 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program for December 2019.
- 5 dogs were returned to their owners through our Return in Field program for December 2019.

### **Dogs:**

- One dog died en route to the shelter after being injured in the field.
- One dog died after an illness which was treated by our veterinary staff.
- One puppy died in foster care.
- Four dogs were humanely euthanized as part of head-to-lab bite investigations.
- One dog was humanely euthanized after being severely injured in the field.
- One dog was an owner requested euthanasia for a seriously ill 15 year old.

### **Cats:**

- One cat died en route to the shelter after being injured in the field.
- One cat died in foster care
- Three cats were humanely euthanized after suffering injuries in the field.
- One kitten was humanely euthanized after failing to thrive.

\* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
