Fort Bend District Clerk Beverley McGrew Walker Announces the Release of The District Clerk's *Annual 2025 Review*

(Richmond, TX)—Fort Bend County District Clerk, Beverley McGrew Walker, announces the release of the District Clerk's *Annual Review* for 2025 during April, County Government Month. The Annual Review is a pictorial compilation of events, activities, work history, and accomplishments which took place in the Fort Bend County District Clerk's Office in 2025. The Review is published annually to provide transparency and accountability to the citizens of Fort Bend County.

District Clerk Beverley McGrew Walker said "I am proud to lead a diligent and highly competent staff. They are a committed, conscientious group of people who take pride in providing first class service to the public. The District Clerk's office is a complex, multifaceted organization that requires a knowledge of legal standards, rules, and statutes promulgated by different agencies. My staff went above and beyond expectations in managing a staff of one hundred ten people to a highly successful year".

In calendar year 2025, the District Clerk's Passport Division processed 31,471 passport applications and collected \$1,353,534.00 for Fort Bend County. The Jury Management Department summoned over 146,000 Fort Bend County citizens to jury duty and did a great job of assembling jurors and managing the process until jurors were sent to their appropriate courts for voir dire. In 2025, the juror appearance rate increased significantly due to activities aimed at showing appreciation for juror service.

The District Clerk's Family, Civil and Criminal Case Management Divisions accepted and processed thousands of case filings via the electronic filing system and over the customer service counter, including new petitions and subsequent filings adhering to the policy of accepting every electronically filed petition before 5 P.M. on the same day it was filed. Additionally, our case management divisions submitted monthly and annual reports to the Office of Court Administration regarding the performance of judges in the district courts as mandated by law.
