FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – February 2018

From February 1, 2018 to February 28, 2018, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 80.08%. The save rate for dogs was 93% and for cats it was 47%. Last month 31 feral cats were euthanized as per the current policies and procedures.

The save rate does not include 11 dogs and 1 cat that were owner requested euthanasia for the entire month of February 2018.

Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.
