FBCAS Monthly Shelter Statistics Report – October 2020

From October 1, 2020 through October 31, 2020, the overall save rate for FBCAS was 95%. The save rate for dogs was 98% and for cats it was 90%.*

- 271 feral/community cats were returned to field as part of our Community Cat Program – a new high for FBCAS.
- 28 dogs and 1 cat were returned to their owners through our Return to Owner/Return in Field programs.
- 319 spay/neuter surgeries were performed by our veterinary team.

Dogs:

- Two dogs were humanely euthanized as part of head-to-lab bite investigations.
- One dog was humanely euthanized due to severe injuries from being hit by a car.

Cats:

- Seven kittens/neonatal died due to failure to thrive.
- Three adult cats were humanely euthanized for severe injuries suffered out in the field after being hit by cars.
- Six cats were humanely euthanized that were brought in with severe illnesses and injuries.
- Two cats were humanely euthanized as part of head-to-lab bite investigations.

* Beginning and ending shelter totals have an acceptable variance of .5% due to database variances in intake and outcome dispositions of the shelter population.

Since August 2018 FBCAS has maintained a 90% or more save rate for the pets that come into our shelter. Our dedicated staff would like to thank all of our adopters, rescue partners, fosters, volunteers and community members who played a part in every life saved at FBCAS this month.
