

Fort Bend County Animal Services Fostering Programs

Finder to Foster Our finder to foster program is open to anyone who finds a stray within our jurisdiction. The finder brings the animal to the shelter for initial intake and then fosters the animal until it is adopted.

Foster to Adopt Our **most popular** is the fostering to adopt program where the foster intends on adopting the animal, but has a **10 day trial period** with the **animal in their home**, to make **sure it's a good fit for the family**. For potential adopters with children and/or other animals, we recommend this option as opposed to adopting outright.

Short-Term Foster Our short term foster program is where the foster only intends to foster for short periods. This could be anywhere from overnight to until adoption day. With our current space crisis, at least two weeks of fostering is requested.



Another type of fostering is our transport fosters. These are people who cannot adopt these particular animals because they are set to go on transport, but they **help foster them until the transport date.** There are several different time frames for these, depending on when the animals are tagged and when the transport leaves.

Underage/Medical

Foster

Our underage/medical fostering program includes our bottle baby puppies/kittens, seniors in need of extra love, hospice (end of life care), and any other animal with special medical needs. (ringworm, scabies, broken limbs, etc.)

Doggy Day Trip

We also have a Doggy Day Trip program where dogs who are fixed and ready for adoption can be **taken out for short trips during our kennel hours.** We ask that you **send us photos and a description of your day together** in order to promote the animals.
