
# FORT BEND COUNTY'S COVID-19 RESPONSE





# FBC SMALL BUSINESS PROGRAM AT A GLANCE

The FBC Small Business Program was launched to provide grants to small businesses significantly impacted by COVID-19 shutdown and on-going impacts.

- CARES Act small business recipients averaged \$17,200 in grantawards.
- ARPA small business recipients averaged \$15,300 in grant awards.
- Businesses were able to use the funds for  $\bullet$ eligible activities such as:
  - job retention, commercial leases, inventory, personal protective equipment, utilities, reopening supplies, and remote working.

# FBC SMALL BUSINESS PROGRAM AT A GLANCE


Over 6,000 small businesses applied for the program and over 4,490 small businesses received financial assistance.

Each Small Business Grant Program offered three (3) levels of grant awards based on the annual income of the applicant within the County.



The ARPA Small Business Grant Program ended in March 31,2023 due to all allocated funds being exhausted. The program is in closeout phase to prepare documentation on the program eligible activities.

Fort Bend County's December 2022 unemployment rate was **3.6%**, showing a significant reduction compared to 12% at the height of the pandemic and 5.2% reported before the pandemic.

Approximately **56%** of the businesses assisted were minority owned and 36% women owned.

Create entrepreneurship and training opportunities through business training courses.

Grants provided approximately **\$27 million** for job creation

Roughly **\$19 million** was provided for lease and mortgage payments to keep the doors open for small businesses.

FBC has provided emergency assistance to more than **2750** businesses, distributing **\$57** million for relief operations through the ARPA program.

FBC's Employment Incentive Program has enabled businesses to hire and retain 202 employees benefiting a total of 63 businesses 13



  - JP Court #2 assistance alone was over \$2.0 million.




