CIT-YOUTH CURRICULUM

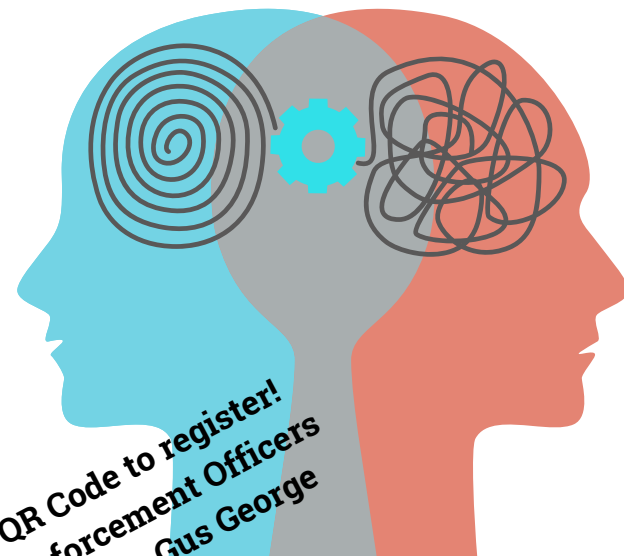
