# WHAT WE DO:


- Provide ongoing behavioral health trainings, and crisis intervention, using trauma informed strategies;
- Provide screening, assessment, and connection to services for youth more at risk for involvement in the justice system; and
- Provide wraparound support/clinical care coordination services for the youth and their caregivers.

### WHO WE SERVE:

Youth and adolescents ages 10-17 years old with suspected mental illness (MI) and/or cooccurring mental illness and substance abuse (CMISA), who are at risk of being, or who are currently involved in the juvenile justice system.

#### WHO WE ARE:

The FOCUS Youth Program (FOCUS) was developed from a grant funded by the Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP). FOCUS is managed by the Behavioral Health Services (BHS) Department of Fort Bend County, and is a countywide, cross-system collaborative approach, involving law enforcement, court, and community partners to address the unique needs of at-risk youth and their families.
