**MOTION FOR PSYCHOLOGICAL EVALUATION BY BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SERVICES OF FORT BEND COUNTY**

- The Court, on its own motion,
  - The State of Texas by and through an Assistant Fort Bend County District Attorney,
  - The Attorney for the Defendant,
- has reason to believe the Defendant is suffering from a mental impairment and an examination is needed to assess psychological functioning, diagnostic impressions, and treatment recommendations. This motion is based on the following behaviors:

**(Check all that apply)**

- Disturbed perceptions*, e.g. talking to persons who are not present, or reports of hearing voices, including commands to harm self or others.
- Disturbed and/or bizarre thoughts and beliefs*, e.g. (including for example only) belief that others are following him/her; grandiose beliefs of having great sums of monies, or contacts with celebrities...
- Disturbed and intense feelings*, e.g. of rage, sadness or depression, and
- Disturbed communications*, e.g. inability to communicate intelligibly about the events leading to arrest.
- Lack of understanding*
- Intellectual Developmental Disabilities*, e.g. intellectual or developmental delays, Autism, Down Syndrome, etc.
