Emergency Solutions Grant Program COVID (ESG-CV)

Fort Bend County was allocated a total of \$2,321,233 in Emergency Solutions Grants Program (ESG) Program funds under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act), Public Law 116-136.

These ESG-CV funds must be used to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus among individuals and families who are homeless or receiving homeless assistance and to support additional homeless assistance and homelessness prevention activities to mitigate the impacts created by coronavirus. The ESG CV projects funded are listed below. The Park Youth Ranch project has been reallocated an additional \$100,750.00 for security improvements.
