Voters Approve County Assistance District #6

Since the inclusion of Mission Bend into Precinct 2 following the redistricting of 2012, Commissioner Prestage has had a vision to make improvements to the area and bring county services to the unincorporated portions of the county. With the passage of County Assistance #6 (CAD #6) in the recent November 5th election, that vision is now closer to being realized.

A County Assistance District (CAD) is a special district created by a county with the power to impose sales taxes. Counties in Texas normally cannot receive revenue from sales and use taxes except by assessing a sales tax through a County Assistance District (CAD). The creation of County Assistance District #6 gives the county the authority to impose and collect an additional 1 cent sale and use tax to be used for improvements in that district only.

County Assistance District #6 is centered along State Highway 6 in the Mission Bend / Four Corners area. On SH 6, it runs as far north as the County Border an as far south as Park Point Drive which is just south of Voss Road. It hugs three major thoroughfares which

The Holiday Season can be difficult times for residents and their families for a number of reasons. However in Fort Bend County, The East Fort Bend Humans Needs Ministry (EFBHNM) and Second Mile Mission Center try to make the holidays a little less stressful by providing decorated baskets filled with food supplies for a complete holiday dinner, and helping spread Christmas joy through special programs.

The East Fort Bend Human Needs Ministry (EFBHNM) Holiday Food Baskets are distributed during the Thanksgiving and Christmas holidays and include everything needed to cook a traditional holiday meal. Families only need to pre-register/sign up to receive a holiday basket on a specified day and then return to pick up the food basket on a designated day prior to the holiday.

Although the East Fort Bend Human Needs Ministry Thanksgiving registration define its east /west boundaries. Along Bissonnet Street it goes from Gaines Road to Sugarland Howell. Along West Bellfort Street it runs from Clodine Road to Belknap Road. Along West Airport Boulevard it extends from 400 feet west of Old Richmond Road to approximately 750 feet east of SH6.

Revenue gained from a County Assistance District can only be used for:

Construction or maintenance of roads or highways;

• Provision of law enforcement and detention services;

• Maintenance or improvement of libraries, museums, parks, or other recreational facilities;

• Provision of services that benefit the public health and welfare, including firefighting services;

 Promotion of economic development and tourism

Commissioner Prestage's vision for CAD #6 is to develop a Multi-Purpose Center that will include a county library, Boys & Girls Club, senior center, and other county services as needed. He plans to make significant improvements to the Four Corners Community Center to include a covered pavilion, additional staff to support programming and increase public safety and security measures in the area with additional lighting, and contract deputies.

His vision also includes

making improvements to roads that were not included in the Mobility Bond Election and construct sidewalks/hike and bike has already passed, there is still time to sign-up for the Christmas Registration period!

Pick-up date/time - Friday, Dec. 20th - 10 am - 1 pm
