Throughout all counties in Texas, Social Services play an important role in finding successful solutions to problems that arise for residents. Fort Bend County Social Services Department offers many services to the community and residents of Fort Bend County. Their purpose is to provide short-term assistance for emergency needs such as utilities, groceries, medications, and rental/mortgage assistance.

Through their motto of "Enriching lives through effective and caring services", the Social Services department provides an array of services to residents:

• Emergency Food Assistance-Food vouchers are provided to those that are in need.

On December 5th, Precinct 2 hosted its 19th annual Cajun-Creole Holiday Party at Fifth Street Community Center in Stafford, Texas. The annual event organized by Commissioner Prestage is a family-style, community get together in celebration of the holiday season. Medication Assistance- Assist residents with purchasing prescription medications for emergency and non-emergency situations.

- Bereavement Services- Assist with cremations or burials to families without adequate resources.
- Utility Assistance- Assist residents who are facing harsh ships with utility bills.
- Rent/Mortgage Assistance- Help residents with rent, mortgage, or emergency shelter needs.
- Benefits Assistance- Assistance with completing applications for SNAP, Medicaid, CHIP, and TANF benefits.

In order to be eligible for these services, residents must be able to provide photo identification; Social Security Cards for all household members; proof of income and/or benefits for the past 30 days; proof of expenditures for past 30 days; and proof of emergency or crisis. 
