Fort Bend County Ranked 5th Healthiest County in Texas



Fort Bend County is the fifth healthiest county in Texas, according to the fifth annual *Health Rankings* released in March 2014, by the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation (RWJF) and the University of Wisconsin Population Health Institute (UWPHI).

"Fort Bend County is very pleased to see these positive health-related measures. We know that having a good job, achieving high educational levels, living in a healthy environment and having access to good health care all contribute to healthy outcomes," said Dr. M. desVignes-Kendrick, Fort Bend County Health & Human Services Director. Each year before schools begins; children of low income families can register to receive a free pair of shoes from select Payless Shoe stores.

The *County Health Rankings* point to the interrelation of factors that improve health outcomes. Public health, medical providers, schools, businesses and many other organizations can all work together to ensure that the great strides made in Fort Bend County are applied to the entire spectrum of illness and to the entire population.

The 2014 *County Health Rankings* rank the overall health of nearly every county in all 50 states. The *Rankings* allow counties to determine how well they are doing on 29 factors that influence health including smoking, high school graduation rates, employment, physical inactivity, and access to healthy foods. Additional **Fort Bend County rankings** among 232 state counties include:

- Health Outcomes-5th
- Length of Life-6th
- Health Factors-4th
- Healthy Behaviors-2nd
- Social & Economic Factors-7th

The *Rankings* provide county-to-county comparisons within a state. Nationally, this year's Rankings show that people living in the least healthy counties are twice as likely to have shorter lives as people living in the healthiest counties. Unhealthy counties also have twice as many children living in poverty and twice as many teen births as the healthiest counties. This year's *Rankings* also feature several new measures including housing, transportation, and access to more information on the program and eligibility requirements, contact Fort Bend County Social Services at **281.403.8050**.
