In celebration of its 50th Super Bowl, the NFL is paying tribute to high schools across the country that helped produce future Super Bowl competitors. Backed by football maker Wilson, the NFL will send every high school that's produced a coach or player that's appeared in a Super Bowl a golden football.

Willowridge High School(WHS) is home to not one but three former Super Bowl Competitors which will bring the gold ball to Chimney Rock Rd. Allen Aldridge, who went on to star at the University of Houston and later drafted and won Super Bowl XXXII with the Denver Broncos. Aldridge is now the Head Football Coach and Athletic Coordinator at Fort Bend ISD Bush High School. WHS alum O.J. Brigance, went on to play at Rice and won a Grey Cup in the Canadian League. He later went on to play in and win Super Bowl XXXV with the Baltimore Ravens where he is currently Senior Player Development Advisor, and also played in Super Bowl XXXVI with the St. Louis Rams.



Last but not least Willowridge graduate and Pro Football Hall of Famer Thurman Thomas is the most decorated of the group to play in a Super Bowl. Thomas
