Fort Bend County Libraries will present **“Couponing with Coupon Kristen!”** with extreme couponer Kristin Holt Duncan, on Saturday, **January 21st**, from 2:00 - 4:00pm, in the Meeting Room at Fort Bend County Libraries’ Missouri City Branch Library, 1530 Texas Parkway.

Holt will provide a basic introduction to “couponing”, the process of collecting discount coupons to save money on food or household purchases. Learn about strategic shopping, meal-planning, and stockpiling, as well as store policies on coupons and discounts. Get tips on helpful technology such as smartphone apps for shoppers.



Holt has been teaching people in the Houston area how to save money by utilizing coupons and discounts for the past eight years. She learned the value of frugality by shopping with her grandmother as a child. In later years, she began “extreme” couponing to stretch her family’s budget.
