Attorneys from Lone Star Legal Aid will be on site at the Willie Melton Law Library on **Mondays**, from **8:30 am to 12:00 noon**, for brief, one-on-one preliminary consultations on a variety of Divil legal issues. Individuals are helped on a first-come, first-served basis; appointments.

Issues that may be addresses include:

- Family Law & family-related legal issues
- Military / Veterans
- Foreclosure
- Landlord-Tenant issues
- Disaster relief
- Employment and wage-claim issues
- Consumer Law
- Wills
