How do I pay misdemeanor court fines?

A: Court Fines can be paid online through the County Clerk's website, in person at the County Clerk's office within the Justice Center, or at one of our three Annex office's located in Missouri City, Sienna, and Katy.

- How do I file a homestead exemption?

- How do I get my Driver's License or renew my Driver's License?
 A: Driver's License and IDs can be received through the Texas DPS office. To find a location near you, please check https://www.dps.texas.gov/section/driver-license.

How do I get a passport? A: Passports are requested through the District Clerk's Office, <u>https://www.fortbendcountytx.gov/government/departments/fort-bend-county-district-clerks-office/passport-applications</u>.

- How do I file an eviction notice?
 A: All eviction suits must be filed in the Justice of the Peace Precinct where the property is located. - How do I register my trailer?

- How do I transfer my car title?

A: No. The County Clerk is authorized by code to take an oath on specific documents filed with our office.
