## Equipment and Procedures Training: Duration and Content:

#### A 3-hour training session, as follows:

For Clerks and Judges (You may schedule your team together):

- <u>Review of equipment, Start up and Shutdown (it is planned to have teams perform a *hands-on*) DS200, Express Vote, Express Touch and Kiosk)</u>
- Opening and Closing poll processes

For Judges only- 2 hour paperwork procedure training classes required:

• Training will focus on filling out proper paperwork for audit purposes.

### Scheduling and Important Notes:

- Election Judges *must email* Maria Rose Gonzalez at MariaRose.Gonzalez@fbctx.gov\_to schedule team members for training. Rose may be contacted for follow-up communications via her direct phone line at (281) 341-8636. Please confirm your training date/time the day before you and your team are schedule to come in.
- <u>Training classes will be limited to 12 trainees and while it will be attempted to schedule</u> teams together, it must be understood that it cannot be guaranteed. Classes will be filled on a first come, first serve basis and Judges should communicate with their team members to determine a 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> choice for the desired class to attend.
- Judges training will be limited to 30 trainees (Judges only will be allowed to attend).
- Walk-ins (those not on appearing on the class roster) will NOT be allowed in *and* any person arriving late will be turned away. Judges are responsible to communicate with their team members to ensure they know the class they are registered for. Judges must understand that the potential for any make-up sessions is *extremely* limited.
- <u>All persons entering the county building **may** wear a face mask.</u>
- **Reminder**: Any person who attends Election Day training, that attended an Early Voting training session, will only be compensated for **one** of the two sessions.
