

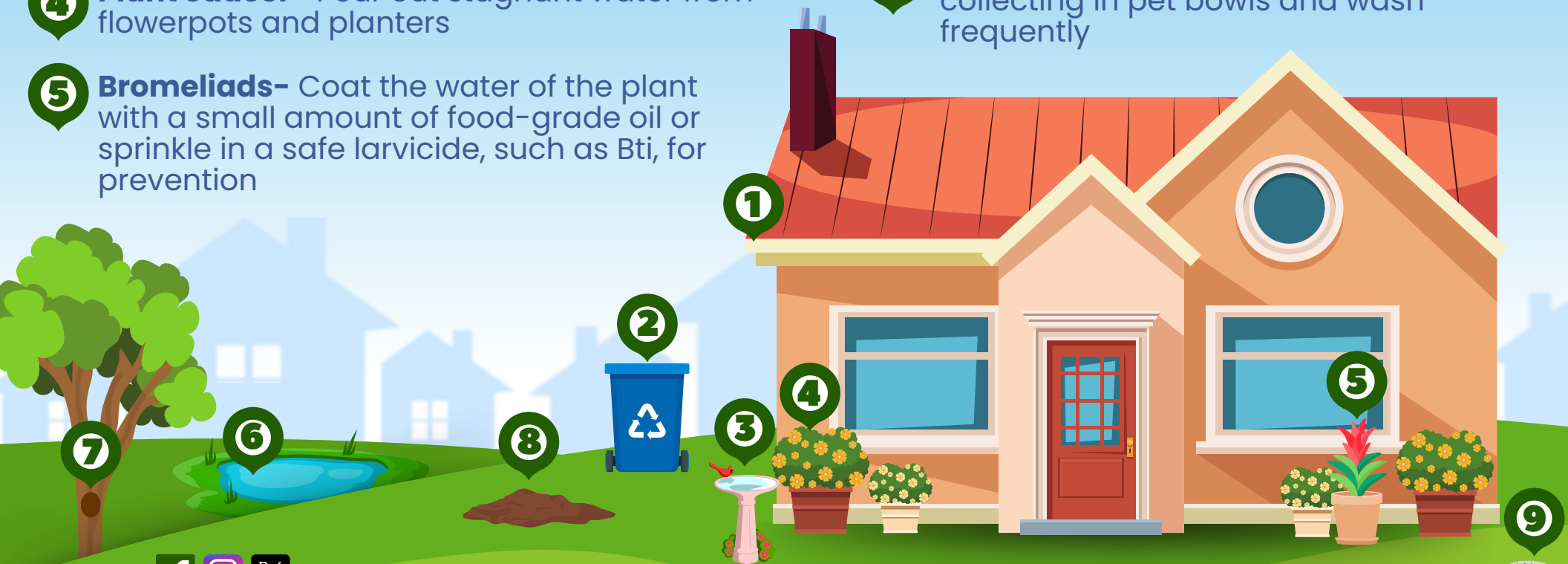
# WHERE ARE MOSQUITOES GROWING AROUND YOU?

Prevent. Promote. Protect.

- 1 Clogged rain gutters**- Remove leaves and other debris from gutters
- 2 Open trash bins**- Ensure bins are tightly sealed and lids aren't flipped upside down
- 3 Fountains & Birdbaths**- Change out the water in fountains and birdbaths every few days
- 4 Plant Saucer**- Pour out stagnant water from flowerpots and planters
- 5 Bromeliads**- Coat the water of the plant with a small amount of food-grade oil or sprinkle in a safe larvicide, such as Bti, for prevention

- 6 Ponds**- Keep ponds adequately treated or stocked with mosquito fish
- 7 Rot holes in trees**- Carefully remove leaves and twigs. Fill holes with tamped-down sand.
- 8 Low areas**- Fill low areas that tend to flood with soil, or treat with larvicide
- 9 Yard drains**- Add a piece of window screen or foam on top of the yard drains
- 10 Water bowls for pets**- Remove water collecting in pet bowls and wash frequently

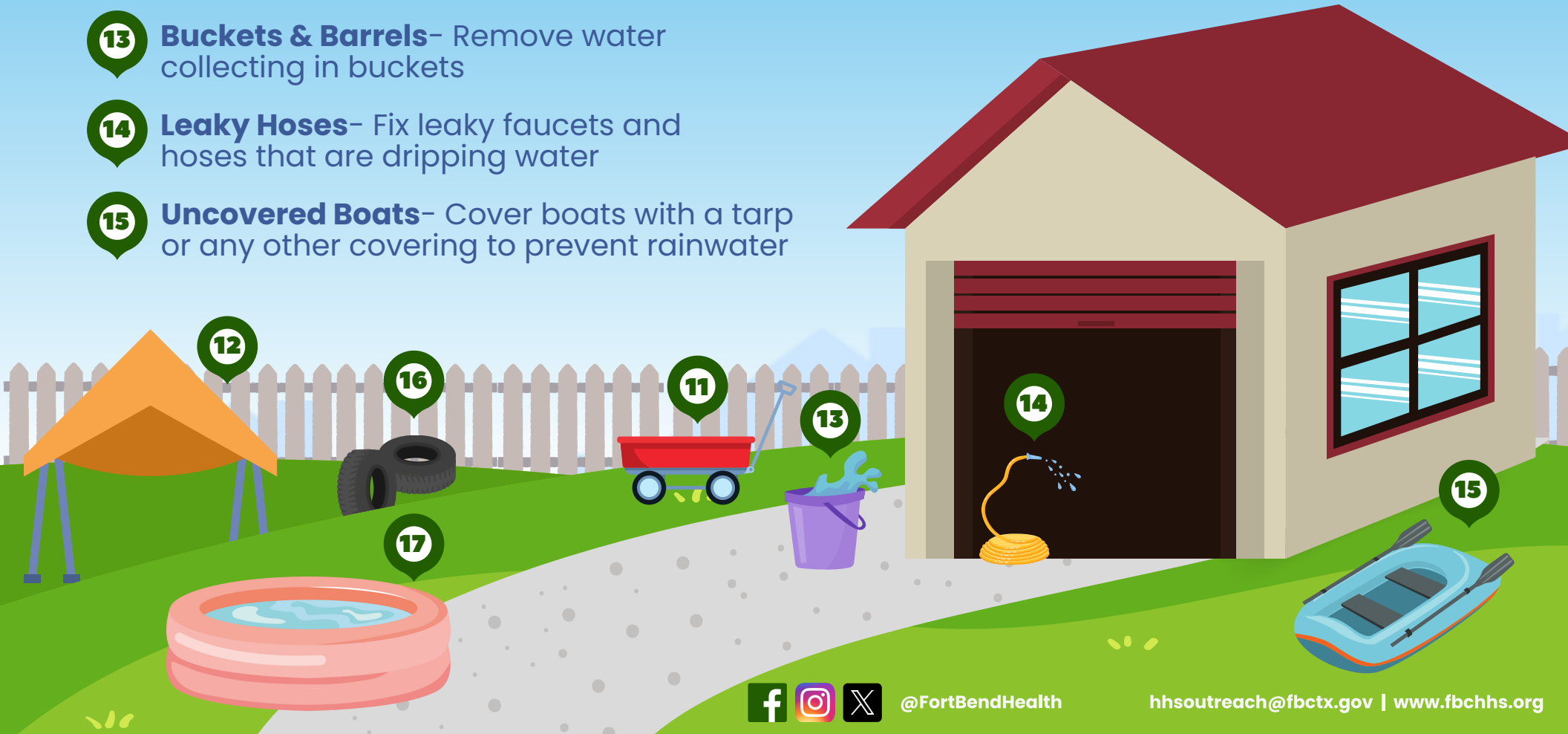


# WHERE ARE **MOSQUITOES** GROWING AROUND YOU?

- 11 Wagons & other toys**– Keep wagons and toys indoors when not in use
- 12 Tarps**– Remove water collecting in pockets of the tarp
- 13 Buckets & Barrels**– Remove water collecting in buckets
- 14 Leaky Hoses**– Fix leaky faucets and hoses that are dripping water
- 15 Uncovered Boats**– Cover boats with a tarp or any other covering to prevent rainwater
- 16 Tires**– Pour out stagnant water or drain water in tires
- 17 Neglected Pools**– Keep pools adequately treated
