Your application packet should include:

- This application, filled out entirely
- The appropriate fee and payment type
- Attach map-showing area, in which fireworks will be detonated, all buildings within six hundred (600) feet of such area, area to be used by spectators, and place of storage of fireworks before and during display.
- Attach copy of surety bond, or certificate of insurance.
- All Company/licensee's business information on separate form (letterhead or business cards or attached paper to application)
- Attach photocopy of pyrotechnic operator's license.
- Fireworks public display permits must be obtained from the State Board of Insurance through the State Fire Marshal. A public fireworks display permit is not renewable and is valid for only one public fireworks display to be held during the hours and on the date or alternate date, if provided, stated on the permit.
- Public Displays: An adult individual or firm, partnership, corporation, or association planning to make a public fireworks display shall submit, under rules adopted by the board, a written application to the State Fire Marshal for a license or permit.
- It is the duty of the appropriate fire prevention officer, as designated or approved by the State Fire Marshal, to make a site investigation to determined whether a proposed fireworks display is of a nature or in a location that may be hazardous to property or dangerous to any person. The officer may, in the exercise of reasonable discretion, approve or disapprove the display site, and may impose reasonable conditions on the display.
