## HAZMAT OPERATIONAL PERMIT APPLICATION

**EFFECTIVE 10/01/2024**

The following fees are hereby established for obtaining permits from the Fort Bend County Fire Marshal's Office. Acceptable forms of payment are paper checks or money orders (made out to Fort Bend County). Fees will be paid prior to the start of the particular process for which the fee is charged. All fees paid to the Fort Bend County Fire Marshal's Office are non-refundable. A submittal is not considered complete until all required documentation, including payment, is received. The total fee for commercial building permits is made up from three separate fees; the plan review fee, the building permit and inspection fee, and the final inspection and Certificate of Compliance fee.

<b>Re-Inspection:</b> Re-inspection fee will be paid prior to re-scheduling next inspection. The fee also covers failure to show up for a scheduled fire inspection without prior notice or if a scheduled fire, inspection is not canceled within 1/2-business day of the scheduled time and date. <b>-\$250</b>

<b>Aerosol Products (IFC 2021 – 105.5.2)</b> An operational permit is required to manufacture, store or handle an aggregate quantity of Level 2 or Level 3 aerosol products, aerosol cooking spray products or plastic aerosol 3 products in excess of 500 pounds (227kg) net weight.	<b>\$300</b>		
<b>Aviation Facilities (IFC 2021 – 105.5.4)</b> An operational permit is required to use a Group H or Group S occupancy for aircraft servicing or repair and aircraft fuel-servicing vehicles. Additional permits required by other sections of this code include, but are not limited to, hot work, hazardous materials and flammable or combustible finishes.	<b>\$300</b>		
<b>Cellulose Nitrate Film (ICF 2021 – 105.5.6)</b> An operational permit is required to store, handle, or use cellulose nitrate film in Group A occupancy.	<b>\$300</b>		
<b>Combustible Dust Producing Operations (IFC 2021 – 105.5.7)</b> An operational permit is required to operate a grain elevator, flour starch mill, feed mill, or a plant pulverizing aluminum, coal, cocoa, magnesium, spices or sugar, or other operations producing combustible dusts as defined in Chapter 2.	<b>\$300</b>		
<b>Combustible Fibers (IFC 2021 – 105.5.8)</b> An operational permit is required for the storage and handling of combustible fibers in quantities greater than 100 cubic feet (2.8 m3).	<b>\$300</b>		
<b>Compressed Gases (IFC 2021 – 105.5.9)</b> An operational permit is required for storage, use or handling at normal temperature and pressure (NTP) of compressed gases in excess of the amounts listed in table 105.5.9 of the adopted code.	<b>\$300</b>		
<b>Cryogenic Fluids (IFC 2021 – 105.5.11)</b> An operational permit is required to produce, store, transport on site, use, handle or dispense cryogenic fluids in excess of the amounts listed in Table 105.5.11 of the IFC 2021. Operational permits shall be renewed annually.	<b>\$300</b>		
<b>Dry Cleaning (IFC 105.5.13)</b> An operational permit is required to engage in the business of dry cleaning or to change to a more hazardous cleaning solvent used in existing dry-cleaning equipment. Operational permits shall be renewed annually.	<b>\$300</b>		
<b>Explosives (IFC 2021 – 105.5.16)</b> An operational permit is required for the manufacturer, storage, handling, sale or use of any quantity of explosives, explosive materials, fireworks or pyrotechnics special effects within the scope of chapter 56 of the adopted code.	<b>\$300</b>		
<b>Hazardous Materials (IFC 2021 – 105.5.22)</b> An operational permit is required to store, transport on site, dispense, use or handle hazardous materials in excess of the amounts listed in table 105.5.22 of the adopted code.	<b>\$300</b>
