2023 ESSAY CONTEST RULES & RESOURCES

RULES

- 1. Essays should be created using 12 point type in Times New Roman font.
- 2. Essays should be submitted in pdf format via email to: <u>HistoricalCommission@fortbendcountytx.gov</u>
- 3. Essays must be received by 5:00 pm on October 30, 2023
- 4. 4th Grade Essays should be between 500-750 words (2-3 pages)
- 5. 7th Grade Essays should be between 750 1000 words (3-4 pages)
- 6. All essays must contain a bibliography with at least 4 references, at least two of which must be primary sources. The bibliography is not part of the word count. A primary source provides first-hand information, an original account produced by a person who experienced an event, issue or topic themselves (might also include data and surveys).
- 7. All essays must contain a title page with the name of the student, the title of the essay, and the name of the school or home address if homeschooled. The title page is not part of the word count.
- 4th Grade Essay Topic: Faces of Fort Bend Explore the life of <u>one</u> of the following notable individuals. Essays should include information about their residence in Fort Bend County, their life experiences, and their important contributions of historical significance – Arizona Fleming, Marcario Garcia, Churchill Fulshear, Jr., or Jesse Dew Agnew.
- 9. 7th Grade Essay Topic: *Moments in Time* Explore <u>one</u> of these major events that impacted the history and legacy of Fort Bend County. Essays should include information such as the location of the event, time/date, key individuals, causes and effects, and historical significance or impact on the present day – Sugar Land 95 Discovery, Settlement of The Old 300, Stafford vs FBISD, or Terry vs. Adams.
