Provides youth an opportunity to spend quality time with a screened and trained positive adult role model. The mentor will offer one to one support, encouragement, a listening ear, problem solving skills and redirection to avoid further interaction with the juvenile justice system. Depending on the youth's status within the department, the visitation occurs in the detention center, school or the community.

- **Must be 21 years of age**
- **Commit to weekly/monthly visits**
- **Fill out an application**
- **Background screening process**
- **Fingerprinting appointment**
- **Attend training and orientation**
