CP #	DDM	Tips & Notes	Verification Code*
0/ Start	N29° 26.121' W96° 00.027'	Start at control point 0, near the start of the paved trail, next to the YMCA pavilion.	
1	N29° 26.040' W96° 00.001'	Next to a tree and paved trail.	
2	N29° 26.060' W96° 00.066'	Near fishing pier/pond.	
3	N29° 26.047' W96° 00.193'	Next to the road.	
4	N29° 25.962' W96° 00.261'	Next to a large tree and a concrete picnic table.	
5	N29° 25.930' W96° 00.394'	Next to the paved trail.	
6	N29° 25.911' W96° 00.524'	Next to the paved trail, close to the San Bernard River.	
7	N29° 25.785' W96° 00.486'	In the woods. Follow Jim Allen Natural Trail, which starts at San Bernard River and the road.	
8	N29° 25.904' W96° 00.341'	From CP #7 continue on the Jim Allen Natural trail towards N/NE. CP#8 is at the intersection of paved and unpaved trail	
9	N29° 25.970' W96° 00.192'	Next to the paved trail.	
10	N29° 26.000' W96° 00.078'	Next to the paved trail and bridge.	

*Validation Code: Note down the letters found on each marker. These letters will help to decode the passcode; CP: Control Point.
