The \$21 million facility, which opened in January 2020, serves as a one-stop shop for Fort Bend County's transportation department, including its administrative, operations, maintenance, fuel depot and bus washing functions.


The new facility allows the County to combine its transportation functions into a single location for improved efficiency and service.

The facility is also a key component of the County's long-range transit plan and is designed for future expansions that will accommodate a 100 percent increase to bus staging capacity.

The Federal Transit Administration and Fort Bend County provided the funding for the project.
