104 - COUNTY GOVERNMENT STRUCTURE

Section 104.01 Government Structure

The governing body of the County is the Commissioners Court, which is comprised of the County Judge and four Commissioners. On or before the last regular term of each fiscal year of the County, Commissioners Court designates a day of the week on which the Court shall convene in a regular term each month during the next fiscal year.

Section 104.02 Elected Officials

Officials elected on a countywide basis are the County Attorney, County Clerk, County Court-at-law Judges, County Judge, County Tax Assessor-Collector, County Treasurer, District Attorney, District Clerk, District Judges, and Sheriff. Officials elected on a precinct level are Commissioners, Justices of the Peace and Constables.
